SAYAW PINOY 2012 IN CONCERT AT THE PARK

This Sunday, February 5, 2012, starting at 5:00 p.m. the NCCA-Dance Committee celebrates National Arts Month in Concert at the Park, with a display of colorful Philippine dances and outstanding dance groups in the country in Sayaw Pinoy 2012, under the artistic direction of Ms. Shirley Halili-Cruz. Ms. Minette Padilla is program host. Admission is free.

Concert at the Park's "Sayaw Pinoy 2012" is a project of the Department of Tourism, under Sec. Ramon Jimenez, Jr., the National Parks Development Committee (NPDC), under Executive Director Juliet H. Villegas, and the National Commission for Culture & the Arts (NCCA) Committee on Dance led by Ms. Shirley Halili-Cruz. NPDC Chief of the Cultural & Public Affairs Mr. Federico A. Edos is the Executive In Charge of the project. Gie V. Arnold writes the script.

Sayaw Pinoy 2012 is one of the seven flagship projects of this year's Philippine Arts Festival. It is an annual event that showcases the colorful tradition of dances and movements in the country, with the aim of teaching in the grassroots level to discover new talents as well as to connect with the other Filipino dance artists in the country. It brings together the different dance forms such as ballet, folk dance, contemporary and modern dances.

For this year's celebration, NCCA's celebration of National Arts Month has the theme "Tradisyon at Inobasyon" which aims to further advance local creativity in the arts.

Admission to Sayaw 2012 in Concert at the Park is free of charge. The public is cordially invited.
